PLEASE DO NOT flush “flushable” wipes down the toilet. Even though they state they are “flushable” they are not! As they make their way down the pipes, rather than breaking down quickly, they start clogs that lead to blockages and cause serious damage. Clogged sewer lines due to the use of these types of items are not normal wear and tear, therefore the damage will be charged to the tenant and can be quite expensive. Throw these types of items in the trash can. Other items not to be flushed are: paper towels; cotton swabs; dental floss; sanitary pads and toilet cleaning pads such as the Toilet Wand Pads are just a few examples.
