*Q&A (Quality Assurance) inspections may take place on work orders and inspections anywhere from 3-5 days after the inspection/work order happened.

- You cannot store anything on top of or around your furnace, this is a fire HAZARD.
- Please make sure that items are cleared from utility room door at all times. We need to be able to access this room at all times.

All trash must be placed in a trash bag and put into the outdoor trash receptacle. If your development has a trash corral, you are not allowed to put any items inside the corral that do not fit inside the cans. Things

such as furniture, electronics, etc. cannot put thrown into the corrals. You need to contact the office and schedule a pick up for these items. There will be a charge for disposal. If items are found in the corral, maintenance will pick them up and dispose of them and everyone in the development will be charged for disposal until it can be determined who the item belongs to.
