Infestations



It is very important that if you notice bugs or rodents of any kind in your apartment, that you call and report this to the office immediately.

Under the new Inspection Protocol with HUD, all they need to do is see evidence of infestation and not necessarily an actual live bug for it to be considered a deficiency.

For a bed bug infestation, they would only need to see dead bed bugs or blood stains on the mattress to be counted as a deficiency.

For cockroaches, they would only need to see the dropping left from the bugs to be counted as a deficiency.

So make sure you are calling in work orders as soon as you see a problem so we can come out and treat accordingly. The longer you wait for treatment, the worse the problem is going to get.

Make sure that you are taking precautions to eliminate and prevent infestations in your unit by inspecting all furniture before bringing it into the unit and not picking up abandoned items from the street. Keep your apartment clean and free of clutter. Make sure you wash all dishes after each meal and clean up any spills as they happen. Put food away in the refrigerator or sealed containers and take out trash on a regular basis.
