Picture #1: It is very important that the windows lock and locks are operable.


Picture #2: Screens with a 1" or larger damage or is completely missing.

All of these are NSPIRE inspection findings with huge point deductions in our inspection scoring.

We will be looking for these things while out doing inspections.

Please check your windows and screens for these issues and if found, call the into the office to be fixed.





SAFETY NOTES:

Learn the location of your smoke detector(s) and how they work. Do <u>NOT</u> take them down or make them inoperable for any reason. If they are going off, please call the office immediately.

Do not flush "flushable" wipes down the toilet. Even though they state they are "flushable" they are **NOT**! They cause blockages and serious damage which you will be charged for if found.

Call the police department anytime vandalism occurs either to your apartment or Housing Authority property. Also report it to the Housing Authority office.

RUMORS ARE UNRELIABLE: Consult the Housing office when in doubt about any subject pertaining to the developments or your unit.
