Summer is here.. A few things to remember while your kids are outside playing: always keep an eye on your children. If you see they have drawn graffiti on the side of your house/unit or sidewalks please remove it. If you do not know who did it, call the local police department. If our maintenance staff notices before it is removed, we will remove it and you will be charged. Also, if your kids are riding bicycles please remind them to be mindful of parked or moving vehicles and stay out of the road.

Any damages to the unit must be reported to the office immediately! Any damages beyond wear and tear will be a charge to you. We will not know the charge until after the work is completed and the work order is returned to the office. Once the work order is complete we will send you a bill in the mail and then you will have 30 days to pay it. Make sure when you are closing your screen door that it is latching. If it is not latched and the wind catches it and it damages the screen door, you will be responsible for paying for the damages.

Keep Roaches Away

Housing Authority maintenance staff are trained and licensed to treat your apartment for roaches and other pests. However, getting rid of roaches (and keeping them away) requires your help, too.

CUT DOWN ON THEIR FOOD SUPPLY

You will leave less food for roaches if you:

- Vacuum or sweep the floor after every meal.
- Wash dishes in soapy, hot water to eliminate all traces of grease.
- Keep trash in a tightly closed container.
- glass jars with screw-on lids
- After a pet has eaten, remove their food bowl and sweep the floor.
- Don't walk around the house eating. Try to keep all your crumbs in one room (less cleaning for you).
- Don't forget to clean crumbs from under appliances daily.

MAKE IT HARD FOR THEM TO HIDE

If they can't hide, you can get them.

Take your recycling out promptly; avoid letting old soda cans, stacks of newspapers and magazines pile up. DRY UP THEIR WATER SUPPLY

Like humans, roaches can go much longer without food than without water. To keep roaches away, keep them thirsty.

Fix dripping faucets, always make sure to call the office and make a work order.

Pour some Lysol into toilets at night to make the water undrinkable

Don't over water houseplants. Soggy soil is a delicious cockroach cocktail.

Pour a little Lysol down your drains nightly to discourage roaches from crawling up into your sink. Keep sink plugs over drains.
