Please do not call the Church. They generously let us use their facility but do not have information for you!!

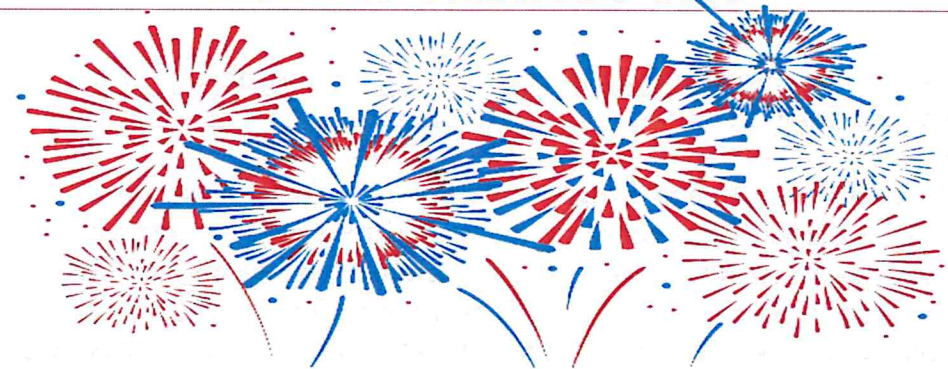
